What is Covered?

Road hazard failure is defined as a tire that becomes unserviceable due to cuts, snags, bruise, non-repairable punctures, or impact damages.

If the road hazard damage is repairable, the tire will be repaired for free.

Replacement Charge

First 2/32 free replacement, \$20.00 mounting and balancing.

After the first 2/32, you will be charged only for the percent of original usual tread worn off plus tax and \$20.00 for mounting and balancing. (Multiplying original cost of tire by the percentage of tread used)

What is no covered: Tires Damaged by/or Failure to...

Willful abuse, Wheel corrosion, Tires run while flat, Improper Inflation, Vandalism, Trailer Tires Commercial use, Accidental Damage, Racing, Off Road use, Irregular or rapid wear, Flat spotting of any kind, Worn mechanical components or misalignment, Loss of time, T.P.M.S. sensors, Consequential vehicle damage, Problems of appearance after 2/32, Fire Damage, Tires transferred from the vehicle they were originally installed on

Warranty is valid for 36 month from the date of purchase.

Warranty is valid for tires that have 4/32 of tread depth or more.

Warranty covers passenger, light truck, and performance tires only.

Owners Obligation

Proper Tire care is necessary to obtain the maximum mileage and wear from a tire. It is consumer's obligation to see that the tire/wheel assemblies are in balance and tires are operated at proper cool inflation pressures and loads.
